Elementary School Projects

1. Stereo Sound System for Gymnasium/Pool, Portable audio amplifier/recording set up for tech lab, Quality high definition video camera/Analog/digital USB interface and tripods (RM48,599.00)

The new pool/gymnasium stereo system, Portable audio amplifier and the HD video camera made a huge debut at Melawati campus during the IASAS Swim Meet on Thursday, January 27th, 2011. The event was made available to the ISKL community via live streaming utilising the HD video cameras. The sound system provided great acoustics. The stereo system is used on a daily basis to enrich the student's physical movement experience during our classes. The whole system is a much-welcomed addition to the P.E. department.

2. Green space for Prep Junior/Senior (RM13,000.00)

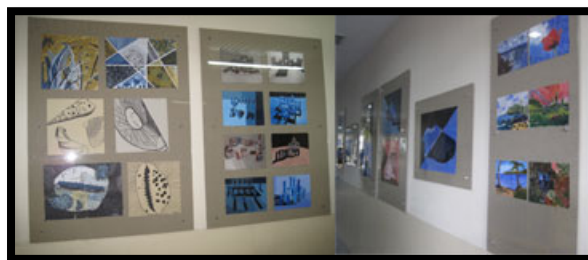
The Early Childhood Green Space is an excellent way for our young children to learn about the natural environment, the world around them in a positive manner, where they are learning by “doing” – digging, planting, growing, caring, and learning. Their enthusiasm for learning has increased by establishing this hands on learning environment, which supports the research that young children learn through “doing”.



Middle School Projects

1. Frames (RM1,000.00)

Student artwork needs to be viewed and celebrated on campus. These frames give art teachers the opportunity to showcase MS student artwork on a daily basis. Aside from protecting it from the elements in the busy hallways, the frames also facilitate the easy change of artwork.



2. Sciences - Adopt a stream Community (RM4,384.00)

Two science classes pioneered the “Adopt-a-stream” project, a first in Malaysia and joined forces with professors and graduate students from Monash University (Kuala Lumpur campus) to monitor the health of a particular stream. The general idea is to collect various physical, chemical and biological data, analyzed it and get an idea of how healthy the stream is. The students experiences and results of the study will be used in the future as more students repeatedly collect data and build an online database in the years to come. Students had the chance to learn outdoors, immersed in nature learning enthusiastically. The Adopt-a-Stream project taught student’s new skills and knowledge, and has laid the foundation for future community stream monitoring projects.

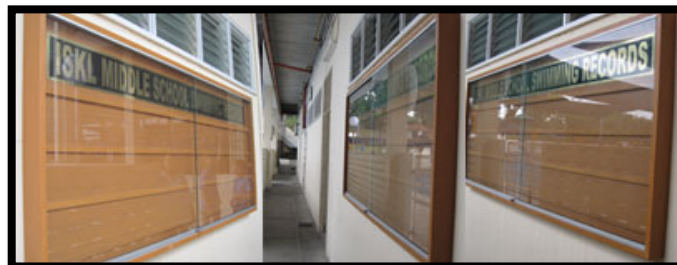
3. Portable DVD player with USB support & Noise blocking headphones (RM800.00)

High & Middle School Projects

1. Theatre renovation - doors replacement (RM42,000.00)

The Robert B. Gaw Theatre was built during the tenure of the third ISKL Head of School and was subsequently named after him. The aluminum-framed doors were recently replaced with soundproof glass doors to improve sound quality within the theatre. Not only do they provide a barrier to keep outside sounds out, they also help reflect sound to the stage, which in return improves performance acoustics. Furthermore, the glass doors are in sync with other improvements to the facilities that have taken place over the last few years.



2. Theatrical body mics (RM14,744.00)

ISKL's "Footloose the Musical" was a huge success for our High School Performing Arts Department and a great way to end 2010. Many people deserved praise but a lot of credit needs to go to equipment that was used. This year, thanks to the Annual Fund, new theatrical body-mics were purchased. These microphones are wireless and need to be placed on the heads of the students so that they do not interfere with the costumes, hair, and movements. But the result is not what is seen, since the microphones are meant to be invisible to the audience, but instead what is heard. In this case, it was quality talent being amplified by quality equipment.

3. Fixed awning for senior deck area (RM5,000.00)

The fixed awning-covering portion of the HS senior deck area has created an expanded area of shade and shelter for students from natural elements.
